1. Participation as a student in a seminar or technical session delivered by ICC, model code organization (ICBO, SBCCI, BOCA) or chapter, related professional society (ACI, AWS, ASNT, PTI, PCA, etc.), state code enforcement licensing agency or standards writing organization (DSA, OSHPD, CALTRANS, etc.), any related federally sponsored program, or any CCTIA-endorsed program.	<b>0.1 for each clock hour of attendance</b>
2. Participation as a student in an accredited academic institution (high school, community college, junior college, university, technical or vocational school).	<b>1.0 for each academic credit hour</b>
3. Successful completion of a self-study course offered by a model code organization (ICC, ICBO, SBCCI, BOCA), state code enforcement licensing agency (DSA, OSHPD, CALTRANS, etc.), or accredited academic institution (high school, community college, junior college, university, technical or vocation school).	<b>1.0 maximum per course</b>
4. Instruction of a seminar or technical session delivered for ICC, a model code organization (ICBO, SBCCI, BOCA) or chapter, related professional society (ACI, AWS, ASNT, PTI, PCA, etc.), state code enforcement licensing agency or standards writing organization (DSA, OSHPD, CALTRANS, etc.), or any related federally sponsored program.	<b>0.1 for each clock hour of instruction</b>
5. Instruction of a course for an accredited academic institution (high school, community college, junior college, university, technical or vocational school). Courses can be counted twice per three-year period, with no limit on the number of different courses	<b>1.0 for each academic credit hour</b>
6. Publication of a paper, book or technical article for an academic institution (high school, community college, junior college, university, technical or vocational school) professional trade journal or model code organization magazine, not to exceed 3.0 CEU's in a three-year period.	<b>1.0 per publication type</b>
7. Attendance at ICC or model code organization (ICBO, SBCCI, BOCA) code development hearings, not to exceed 2.0 CEU's annually.	<b>1.0 per hearing (10 clock hours)</b>
8. Employment as a Building Official, Plans Examiner, Permit Technician or Inspector.	<b>1.0 per three-year period</b>
9. Committee or Board service to ICC, model code organization (ICBO, SBCCI, BOCA) or chapter for one full year, not to exceed 1.0 CEU's annually.	<b>0.5 per committee</b>
10. Obtaining an additional ICC certification through successful testing.	<b>0.5 per certification</b>
11. Preparing for and taking an ICC certification exam but receiving an unsuccessful score.	<b>0.1 per certification exam</b>
12. Retesting is an acceptable alternative to participating in continuing education activities, when the appropriate test is again passed.	n/a
13. For Legacy Certificate Holders ONLY – successful completion of take home exam.	<b>0.5 per certification</b>
